Located in Somerset, Ohio and serving customers around the world, Schmelzer Industries proudly continues a tradition of quality products and excellent service.

Reusing what they can, as well as recycling!

- ⇒ "We deliver up to one ton of cardboard per month to Perry County Recycling Center in New Lex and save about \$400 per yr on landfill costs. We also recycle electronic equipment, batteries, plastic jugs/bottles, and office paper.
- ⇒ For the past 4 years we have been returning our largest wooden pallets from a customer in New Jersey and reusing them. This has redirected 3.8 tons per yr away from landfill and saved us \$30,000 annually.
- ⇒ We deliver 30 loads (100 lbs ea.) of cardboard core annually to Fairfield County Recycling & Litter Prevention. This has redirected 3,000 lbs away from landfill." ~Tim Schmelzer, Eng. Manager

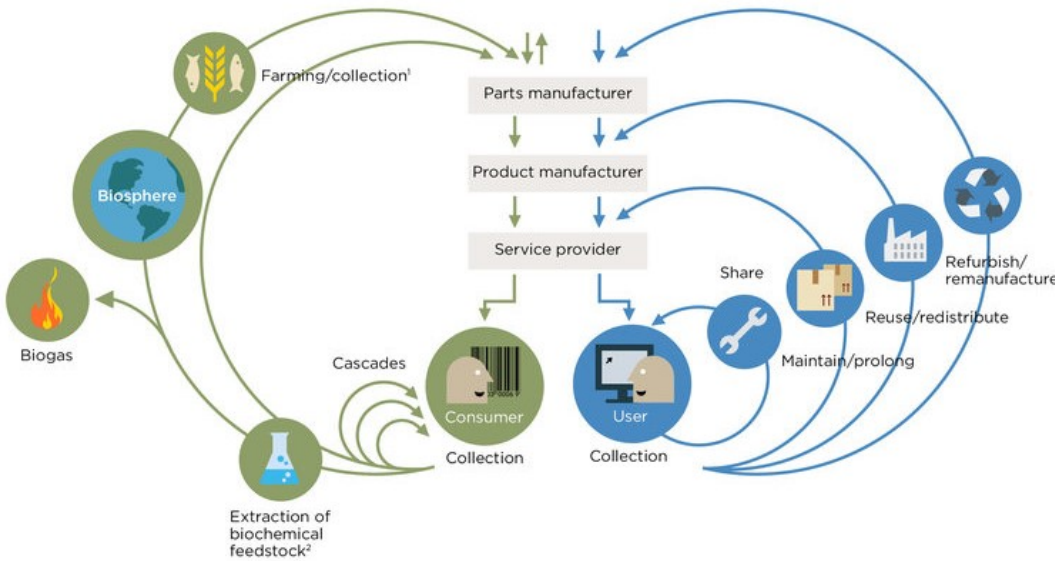
