Part-Time Public Health Nurse Opportunity

The Perry County Health Department has an exciting opportunity for a part-time, temporary Public Health Nurse. The Public Health Nurse provides vaccinations, tuberculosis (TB) skin testing, blood pressure monitoring, and head lice management.

Minimum Qualifications for the Public Health Nurse position: currently licensed as a registered nurse pursuant to Section 4723.13 of the Ohio Revised Code. Applicants must have a valid Ohio Driver's License, with ongoing proof of auto insurance also required.

The Perry County Health Department is committed to creating a diverse environment and is proud to be an equal opportunity employer. All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, gender, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, national origin, genetics, disability, age, or veteran status.

The pay for this position is \$21.63 per hour for 24-29 hours per week. This temporary position is estimated to be needed from August 1, 2024 to January 31, 2025, with some flexibility. The Perry County Health Department participates in the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System.
